

BoCC Meeting Recap 05.04.21

- The Board of County Commissioners (BoCC) considered and approved an application for a Colorado Liquor sales room for the Storm Cellar.
- BoCC considered and approved a **May Mental Health Month in Delta County** proclamation.
- BoCC considered and approved the North Fork EMS annual ambulance license and permits.
- BoCC considered and approved the final bid tally for 2021 RFP-13; Asphalt was awarded to Sun Corp and Emulsion was awarded to COBITCO.
- BoCC considered and approved the National Forest Payments Funding to be distributed between Delta County School District, Delta County Contingency Title III, and Delta County Road & Bridge.
- BoCC filled two vacant seats on the Hotchkiss Cemetery Board; Steve O'Connell and Sherri Crain.
- The board terminated a lease with the US Department of Interior BLM regarding the Communications Use Lease for Youngs Peak. The board also considered and approved a resolution gifting the Colorado Office of Information Technology the County's communications tower and supporting infrastructure, located on Youngs Peak.
- BoCC heard a request from the Delta County Livestock Association regarding a potential resolution opposing Initiative 16.

- The Board of County Commissioners recognized the North Fork Pool and Recreation District for their Starburst Award from the Great Outdoors Colorado Award. See picture below.
- BoCC considered and approved the Human Services plan for two additional eligibility technician positions.
- BoCC considered and approved an airport ground lease - North Fork Valley Airport Hanger #377.
- The board considered and approved one deed for County sold properties, and one deed for County sold mineral rights.
