- No update required for Unaffiliated Voters
- ✓Update your address (mailing and physical)
- √Verify your voter information

# WHO CAN REGISTER TO VOTE?

#### Who is Eligible to Register:

- ✓U.S Citizens
- ✓ Pre-Register 16-17 Years
- ✓ 18 Years eligible to vote (17 year olds can vote in the Primary Elections if 18 by Nov 3)
- ✓ Must be a Resident of Colorado 22 days prior to any election

## WHAT TO KNOW FOR THE 2020 ELECTIONS

#### Important Facts for 2020 Elections:

- ▼There WILL be Presidential Candidates on the March Presidential Primary Ballot
- ✓ You MAY affiliate/change parties29 days before a Primary Election
- ✓ The June Primary will NOT contain Presidential Candidates

#### **24 DROP OFF LOCATIONS**

Delta County now has 4 stand alone drop off locations. These locations will be open 24 hours starting the first day ballots can be mailed for each election (22 days prior).

Other drop off locations will be notated in the voter instructions per each election as the alternate locations change on an as needed basis.

Our 4 locations for each State and Federal Election will be:

Delta Courthouse - 501 Palmer St, Delta North Fork Annex - 196 W Hotchkiss Ave, Hotchkiss Paonia Town Hall - 214 Grand Ave, Paonia Cedaredge Library - 180 SW 6th Ave, Cedaredge

### **2020 ELECTIONS**

In 2020 Delta County will conduct upwards of 5 elections throughout the year. Starting off on March 3rd with the first Presidential Primary the State has seen in 20 years. This will be the first Presidential Primary that unaffiliated voters will be able to participate in.

#### **NEW THIS YEAR**

Starting in 2020 pre-registered voters who are 17 years of age but will turn 18 years of age on or before November 3, 2020, will be eligible to vote in the Primary Elections for that year.

#### **WHAT'S THE SAME**

All four of our 24 Hour Drop Box Locations will be available during State Elections (2020: Presidential and State Primaries and General)

Unaffiliated voters will receive both major party ballots in their Primary packets. Remember U-Choose and only return ONE voted ballot.

## REMINDER

If any of your addresses change, (physical or mailing) you need to update your registration to ensure that you get everything your home address allows you to vote on.
